

Union Journeyman Taper:

The following is a brief description of the responsibilities if employed by AACP as a Journeyman Taper. We are looking to hire a skilled Union Taper who is detail-oriented and has knowledge of finishing techniques. A successful applicant should be hardworking, reliable, punctual, and have good communication and organizational skills.

As a Union Taper, you would be expected to have a strong understanding of taping and the materials used in your trade,

Some specific qualifications/experience of a Union Taper might include:

- 1. Strong attention to detail, while focused on safety, quality, consistency, and production.
- 2. Knowing all the steps for this trade, not taking short cuts.
- 3. Knowledge of how to run, clean, and maintain Automatic Taping Tools.
- 4. Perform finishing work on existing and new installation of different drywall products in a safe and timely manner.
- 5. Should be certified/trained in equipment such as boom lifts/scissor lifts.
- 6. Good communication skills.
- 7. Work collaboratively with other finishers and supervisors, serving as leadership.
- 8. Be able to pass a Drug Test.
- 9. Should be in good standings with the Union.
- 10. Physically fit and able to perform tasks such as lifting, climbing, and bending.
- 11. Follow safety procedures and guidelines to ensure a safe work environment for yourself and others.
- 12. Open to new ideas, methods, teamwork, collaboration.
